UNSO is the United Nations Support Office in Somalia led by the Department of Field Support. The Security Council established UNSO on 9 November 2015 replacing the previous mission, UNSOA (UN Support Office for AMISOM).

- 2 The largest UN-mandated peace support operation, the African Union Mission in Somalia (AMISOM)

UNSO WORKS IN A DANGEROUS AND CHALLENGING ENVIRONMENT

- 3 out of 4 IED [Improvised Explosive Devices] attacks occur on main supply routes
- on average every 10 weeks UN personnel and facilities come under attack

UNSO PROVIDES EQUIPMENT AND MISSION SUPPORT SERVICES

- 30 Million litres of diesel fuel per year
- 4 Fixed Wing
10 Helicopters
- over 23,000 Tons of rations delivery per year
- 610 Medical Evacuations
1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015
- 12,000 specialised training to AMISOM Personnel from Uganda, Burundi, Kenya, Djibouti, Ethiopia, Nigeria and Sierra Leone
- plus training in Human Rights to all AMISOM military personnel
