- Cyprus (6 civilian police members)
- South Sudan (14 civilian police members)

Bosnia and Herzegovina considers to increase its contribution, but still waiting to complete the internal approval procedures.

In addition, I would like to emphasize that Peace Support Operation Training Center in Bosnia and Herzegovina conducts a couple of courses certified by the UN, such as:

- Utility of Gender in PSO,
