**THE CURRENCY OF TIMOR LOROSA'E IS THE U.S. DOLLAR (US\$) AS ADOPTED BY THE NATIONAL CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL ON 24 JANUARY 2000 IN REG No. 2000/7**

**The US\$ comes in these denominations**

**\$ 1.00**

**\$ 5.00**

**\$1.00 bill = 100 pennies = 20 nickels = 10 dimes = 4 quarters**

**\$1.00 = 100 cents**

**one penny = 1 cent**

**one nickel = 5 cents**

**one dime = 10 cents**

**one quarter = 25 cents**



**The amount of Rupiah that is equivalent to US\$1 may change daily. For the month of May, for instance, the US\$1 was equivalent to an average of Rupiah 8,309, and fluctuated between 7,960 and 8,685.**

**The U.S. dollar may also be exchanged for other currencies such as the Australian dollar and the Portuguese Escudo. The exchange rates for these currencies against the U.S. dollar also fluctuate daily. For example, for the month of May, the Australian dollar traded at an average of A\$1.7265 and fluctuated between A\$1.6767 and A\$1.7596.**

**On a daily basis, the Central Payment Office publishes indicative rates for the US\$ against the Rupiah, Australian dollar and other selected currencies. These rates may be used as a guide for exchange transactions and currency conversion on the local market.**
